ALL THINGS ARE TEMPORAL.

When Pastor requested that we complete a list of things that we hold most dear to us I immediately put my soul salvation as the most important thing in my life. After I was finished with #1 it was difficult for me to come up with anything else, but as I sat there I had to be honest with myself that there are people and things that I cherish. So, I began to compile my list, and it consisted of myself, my spiritual family, my natural family, my job and my car.

Shortly thereafter, Yah began to touch the items on my list. In October of last year, my employer presented me with a teaching contract that would only be good through June of this year. I immediately thought the reason for the contract was about my choice in requesting time off for the Holy Days and obeying YAH since previously my job had given me opposition concerning this. I signed the contract and never compromised or rationalized when I submitted my request to have the Holy Days off again. I thought to myself that I may not even be alive to see June, so whatever happened would be according to Yah's will.

Next, I began having health issues, which resulted in tests being ran for cancerous tumors. Never having any major health issues in the past, this took me by surprise, and looking back, I can say I took my health for granted. I wondered if I was being punished because of the things I did in the past before coming into the knowledge of the truth. I had to stop myself from thinking this way because if it continued, I could have easily stopped walking into holiness.

A few months later, I was involved in a car accident which resulted in my vehicle being totaled. Although not injured, the incident served as a reminder that Yah can take my life at any moment and it is by His grace that I am alive.

Prior to coming into holiness, my cousin and I had a close relationship. But when I started to live my life according to the Word of Yah our relationship became distant. Our relationship further declined when I moved to Atlanta to be closer to where the Word was being preached. Out of the things that were touched on my list, this was the most painful to accept because I love my natural family and was always close to this particular family member. Although I knew that the Word could cause a separation to occur even among family, I was still down hearted about the situation. I did not stay down for long because I began to think of the reason I chose to walk in holiness; which was to be saved. I was not going to risk losing my salvation for the sake of a relationship with anyone.

When these items were touched I never had the mind to give up or quit. Looking back on it now, I understand that because I placed my soul salvation as my number one priority, the other things on the list would be tested. In the end, I learned positioning anything above my soul salvation and service to Yah could result in these very same things being removed. So I labor for the things that are eternal and not temporal.
